At this time of year I am reminded of a favorite quote-"If you can't feed a hundred people, then feed just one." Mother Teresa. We hope you will find it in your heart to reach out and help others this holiday season.

We have been busy like the leaves that fall throughout the autumn; there is change all around. You may have heard by now of several changes occurring within Inter-Faith Ministries to better position the organization to serve the homeless and poor in Wichita. As the President of the Inter-Faith Ministries Board of Directors I'd like to make sure everyone is aware of both the changes and the renewed vigor and dedication we have asked of each Board member and staff person.

community and the Board hopes to continue to strengthen these relationships.

I'm also very pleased to announce that Garland Egerton has joined the staff as Interim Executive Director. His previous business experience combined with a strong interest in Inter-Faith Ministries' mission makes him ideally suited to lead the organization as we work through some important changes. Garland has hit the ground running. We're grateful to Anne Corriston for her work with Inter-Faith over the past few years and equally grateful to

Garland for stepping in to move the organization forward. In the coming weeks and months the Board and staff will be focusing on what makes IFM unique in serving the community. We house more homeless people than any other organization in Wichita. We are the only

organization that shelters single women who are not victims of domestic violence. We operate one of only a handful of shelters in the United States that serves chronically homeless people with mental illnesses. We operate low-income apartments, giving people with previous rental difficulties a place to live and rebuild credit and lives.

That part of our mission is accomplished only by continuing to focus on another part of it - bringing together people of different faiths to communicate with one another, to work together to make Wichita a stronger community.

I join Garland and my fellow Board members in encouraging each of you to communicate with us. Garland can be contacted at the Inter-Faith office, 264-9303. My office number is 269-3935. Your input is vital to the health and work of Inter-Faith Ministries.

#### Meet Suzy Abdelfarag

Suzy Abdelfarag joined the Inter-Faith Ministries staff in July as an AmeriCorps VISTA worker, and the place hasn't been the same since!

Suzy's enthusiasm is contagious. She grew up in the Sudan, emigrated with her family to Nashville, TN when she was 12, and attended college in Nashville before heading here to the "Wild West." Her first requests upon arriving in Wichita were to see Indians and bison.

Suzv's main focus in the coming months will be with Operation Holiday. working to schedule volunteers, and in communications and programs for our partner congregations.



"I'm having a good time meeting people from the different faith groups and congregations in Wichita," said Suzy. "Inter-Faith Ministries is working to connect with all our partners and really promote some activities and

### **Warming Souls Winter Shelter**

After a long, hot, humid summer most of us are happy to see cooler days finally arrive. For many of the people Inter-Faith Ministries helps, however, the cooler days herald a time when sleeping outside is dangerous.

Warming Souls Winter Shelter provides shelter during the five coldest months of the year. As many as 130 men and 35 women seek shelter each night from November 1 to March 31.

"Our year round shelters don't have enough beds to take care of everyone in need," said Interim Director Garland Egerton. "Warming Souls used to be called the Overflow because it fills that gap - making sure we take care of everyone who needs a place to sleep during the winter. It's also a shelter with fewer regulations than a full time shelter, so it serves a broader population."

Guadalupe Clinic will once again provide medical care, including flu shots, tuberculosis tests, smoking and alcohol counseling, and basic first aid at Warming Souls. The goal is to improve the health of the homeless, which will increase their ability to change their lives. It also cuts down on visits to the emergency room.

Advocates to End Chronic Homelessness (AECH) is conducting a fundraising campaign specifically for the Winter Shelter. <u>Click here to donate</u>.

Each evening for the five months Warming Souls operates, volunteers provide meals. If you have a group interested in helping, please contact Bonnie Toombs, 316-269-3935.
